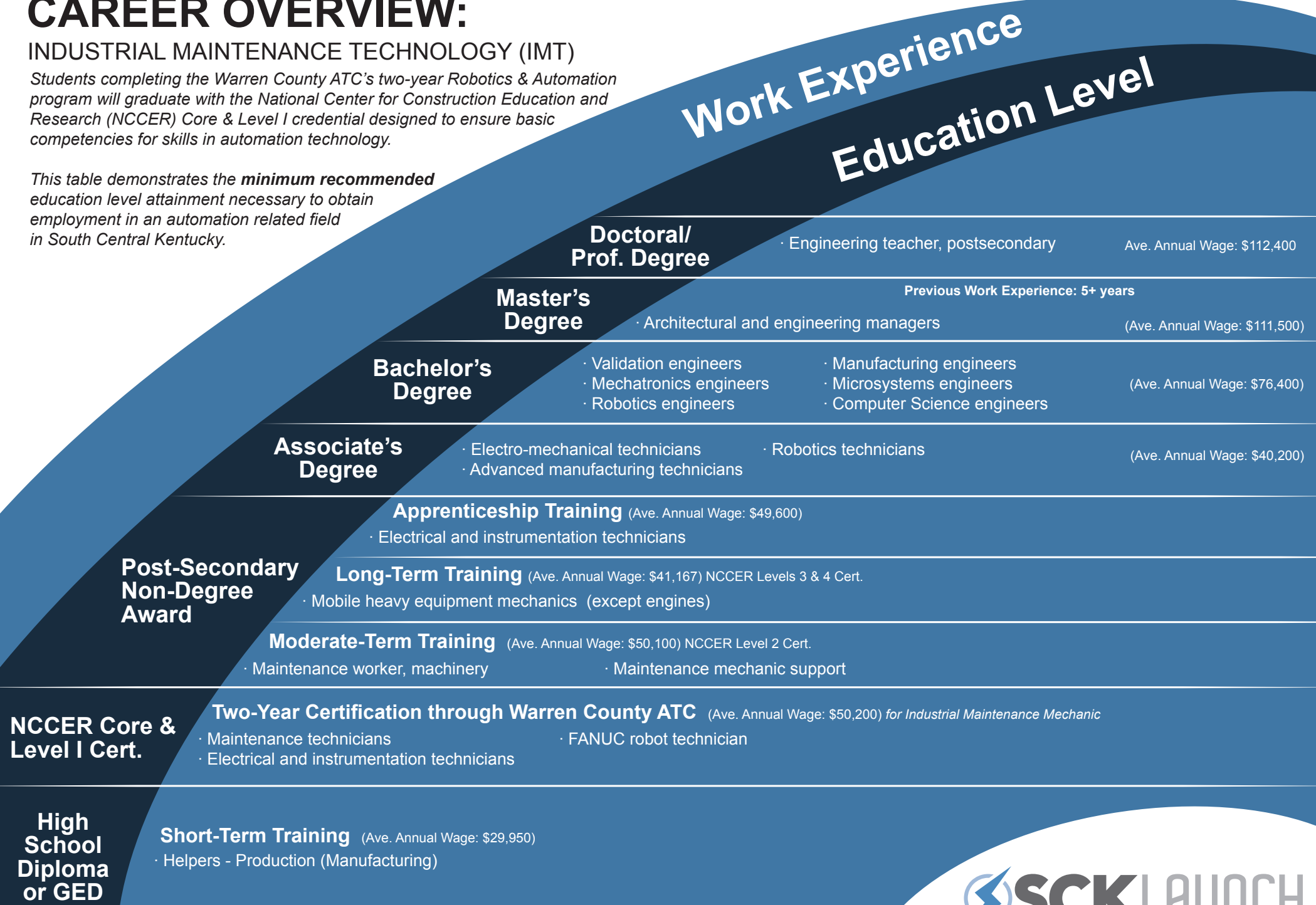


ROBOTICS & AUTOMATION TECHNOLOGY CAREER OVERVIEW:
